While Constance Roberts brought lots of strong visual excitement to the exhibit, her sister Jo Ennis added literary interest with her poems and prose. Jo advised that, "Many people like to collect things and one of my collections is words. Poetry is my way of assembling this collection of words. So often words run around in my thoughts and need somewhere to fall, so I drop them on paper, for often times there is no one around to hear what I am thinking. Capturing these words on paper allows me and others to then at a later time see what the collection looks like. When words aren't quite enough, then it is time to draw, paint or sculpt, other hobbies of mine."

Photography for Artists Seminar

Arts Rolla Seminar - September 25

Photographing Your Artwork for Shows Juried from Photos

Arts Rolla is pleased to offer a 1/2 day seminar taught by Garry McMichael that shares insights on how to photograph artwork so that it accurately represents the caliber of work. This is sure to help the artist put their best foot forward when shows are juried from photographs.

Emphasis will be on "Digital Photography Basics" to help artists take better photographs of their artwork for use on the internet, to enter competitions, and to make Giclee prints and 35mm slides.

Students will learn:

- An overview of your camera and the settings to set /change color balance, iso and digital resolution
- Equipment and set up to photograph 2D artwork
- How to zoom-in (crop), straighten and square up your image
- How to correct the exposure and color balance
- Photograph your artwork outdoors using daylight as the light source
- Simple techniques to photograph artwork indoors with supplementary lighting
- An overview of photographing pottery and jewelry

Students need to bring:

- Digital Camera (We are only working with digital formats, no 35 mm)
- Your Camera's instruction book
- Tripod if you have one. (Not required)
- A piece of art to photograph (Optional – no larger than 18" x 24")

The class will be held on September 25, 2010, from 9:30 AM to 1:30 PM in the Multi-Purpose Room of the Phelps County Courthouse. Cost is \$25.00. Class size is limited so sign up now by calling Arts Rolla at 573 364-5539.

This group was the catalyst for bringing the art community together. Throughout the years the organization has evolved and the name has been changed to Arts Rolla. However, the solid foundation this group built has been a critical part of the success we enjoy today in Arts Rolla. Because of their leadership, the art in our region is vibrant and growing.

It's Curtain Up at Leach Theatre: 2010 Schedule

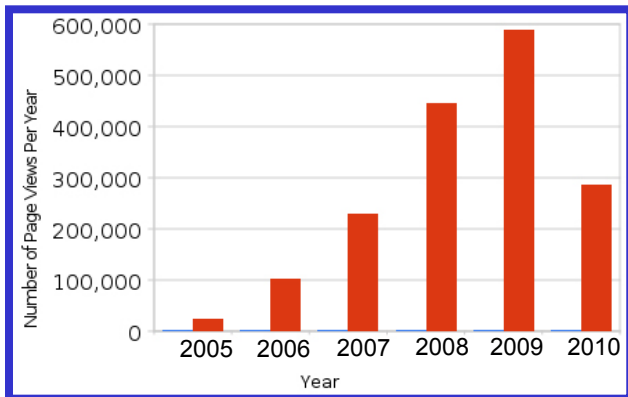
