The Exhibition will run Tuesday, October 27 to Tuesday, November 24, 2020.

First Friday Opening Reception: November 6, 2020 will be held virtually. Works of art receiving recognition will be revealed at 6 pm on November 6, 2020 on Facebook and also on the Arts Rolla website.

Entries received: Tuesday, October 27 from 10 a.m. to 2 p.m. at The Centre.

End-of-show pick up: Tuesday, November 24, 2020 from 10 a.m. to 2 p.m. at The Centre.

Judges: MARY LOU CORN & LUCE MYERS

Mary Lou Corn has been painting professionally for over 50 years. She is a member of the National Watercolor Society, Missouri Watercolor Society, Kansas Watercolor Society, and the Honor Society of Watercolor USA. She majored in art William Woods College in Fulton, MO and studied with several noted American watercolor artists such as Stephen Quiller and Nina Engle. Her work has received national recognition and is exhibited in several corporate galleries.

Luce Myers is a professor of art at Missouri S&T, and has taught drawing, painting, sculpture and art appreciation for many years, as well as teaching in the Rolla Public School system for 15 years prior. She has shown her art at the Centre, at Framations Gallery in St. Peters, MO, Meramec Vineyards Winery, the Missouri Botanical Gardens, as well as in Missouri S&T art exhibitions. Her prime medium is clay and other 3-D sculpture and relief. She will be judging the 3-D category.

Conditions of Entry: more details are on the back

Conditions of Entry:

- 1. Artists must be 18 or older and may submit 1- 2 (total) entries.**
- 2. All artworks must be submitted with a completed entry form and payment of fee.**
- 3. Entry Fee: ARTS ROLLA Members - \$15.00; Non-Members - \$30.00. Entry fees and donations will be applied toward the expenses and awards of this exhibit. **In order to receive member discount on the entry fee, artists may join ARTS ROLLA when entering the show.****

All entry fees are payable to ARTS ROLLA and are non-refundable.

4. Each entry must be labeled on the back with the name, address, and phone number of the artist, title of the entry, date created, and medium. Please use a separate label for each work. Medium examples: Oil, Acrylic, Watercolor, Pastel, Pencil, Ink, Collage, Sculpture, Wood/stone carvings, Metal work, Hand-built pottery, etc. **(No Photography).**

5. Due to space available, maximum size of entry is 144” circumference including the frame, (Examples of maximum size is 2'x4' and 3'x3').

6. **ALL Hanging art must be framed with wire securely fastened across the back. Saw-tooth or loop hangers, duct tape, or other non-wire material will be accepted.** 3-D must be small enough to fit in a glass case or large and durable as a floor or pedestal display. Entries will be checked for compliance of size, wiring, and information when the artwork is submitted.
7. **Artwork must not have been previously submitted in ARTS ROLLA competitions and must not be over 2 years old.** Entries must be original artwork. No commercial molds, patterns, prints, crafts, or kits will be accepted. (Contact Arts Rolla with questions.)
8. **ARTS ROLLA and the City (The Centre) reserve final approval of all artwork to be displayed.** The Centre is a family friendly venue which welcomes a diverse community.
9. **Sales:** Entrants are encouraged to price their work at their established market price. This price may not be altered during the run of the show. All sales attributed to the exhibition shall be transacted between the Buyer and ARTS ROLLA, who shall retain a 20% commission.
10. **Handling Fee:** Artists are responsible for making arrangements to pick up/sign-out their entries at the end of the exhibit. Artworks that are not picked up will be stored in the ARTS ROLLA office, and a **handling fee of \$10.00** will be charged. After one month, unclaimed artwork will become the property of ARTS ROLLA.
11. **Agreement:** The Centre provides general security during the exhibit, and ARTS ROLLA will handle all entries with care when hanging the show. ARTS ROLLA and its representatives or sponsors will not be held responsible for damage, theft or loss during the competition or related storage or handling, or because of failure to pick up entries as specified. **ARTS ROLLA assumes the right to photograph any entry submitted for educational and/or publicity purposes only.** Entries cannot be removed before the close of competition. The signing of an entry form will be understood to imply agreement on the part of the artist with all of the conditions mentioned within this invitation.
