Holloway, Rolla MO. This exhibit will feature original artworks created by high school aged artists alongside other Missouri artists. Student art will be judged separately from professional pieces.

Only original artwork will be accepted. No commercial or teacher-made patterns. No commercial crafts. Hanging art can be no larger than 36"x 36" and must be wired for hanging. 3-D art should not be bigger than 24" and able to fit in the glass cabinets at The Centre. Stands for 3-D art must be supplied by the artist. 3-D sculpture may also be submitted; however, these works must be able to stand on their own and cannot easily be tipped. The Centre provides general security and Arts Rolla handles artwork with care; therefore, will not be held responsible for damage or theft during the exhibit.
